This inductive Bible study will examine the life of David, Israel's second king and his relationship with God. You will study God's nature as revealed through Old Testament Scriptures that focus on how David served God and how David sinned against God. David's response to his trials, tragedies, and triumphs will inspire you and encourage you in your own commitment to God. In addition, the study will offer a time of reflection in the Psalms that relate to events in David's life. You will see the source of David's inspiration, and be led in a time of daily worship.

Throughout the study, examine David's character, to learn from his life, his successes and his sin.

Throughout the study, examine God's character, His nature and His attributes, His past care, His present concern, and His promises for the future.

This inductive study will use the Bible as the primary source of information. The inductive method includes four steps. First you will be asked questions to help you carefully *observe* the text as you "read with a purpose." The next step involves careful and accurate *interpretation* of the Scriptures being studied, that you might determine *eternal principles* from the text, and then *apply* these Scriptures to the circumstances of your life.
