This inductive study of the New Testament book of Galatians will challenge you to examine your own faith and commitment to the Lord. The study will investigate Galatians' timeless truths that convict and inspire people of all ages. The lessons will seek to equip you to be stronger and more mature in your walk with the Lord Jesus. These lessons also include an in-depth study of the fruit of the Spirit as the focus of Day 5 each week.

Dr. M. Robert Mulholland wrote a very simple definition to describe the phrase *spiritual formation*, when the Christian is "in the process of being conformed to the image of Christ for the sake of others." Would you be willing to make that a goal for yourself as you study the book of Galatians? Please consider allowing God's word to lead and equip you in this way.

This inductive study will use the Bible as the primary source of information. The inductive method includes four steps. First you will be asked questions to help you carefully *observe* the text as you "read with a purpose." The next step involves careful and accurate *interpretation* of the Scriptures being studied, that you might determine *eternal principles* from the text, and then *apply* these Scriptures to the circumstances of your life.
