

This inductive Bible study focuses on the words that Christ spoke in His Sermon on the Mount taken from Matthew 5-7. The lessons examine Jesus' message that challenges on a wide variety of subjects, including the blessing of obedience. The study leads participants to understand their place in God's kingdom and to be encouraged to live out their faith in Christ. The in-depth fourteen week study asks students to examine their own relationship with the Lord as well as with others in the church. The lessons seek to equip each student to be stronger and more mature in their walk, as well as united with others in the faith.

Dr. M. Robert Mulholland wrote a very simple definition to describe the phrase *spiritual formation*, when the Christian is "in the process of being conformed to the image of Christ for the sake of others." Would you be willing to make that a goal for yourself as you study the Sermon on the Mount? Please consider allowing God's word to lead and equip you in this way.

This inductive study will use the Bible as the primary source of information. The inductive method includes four steps. First you will be asked questions to help you carefully *observe* the text as you "read with a purpose." The next step involves careful and accurate *interpretation* of the Scriptures being studied, that you might determine *eternal principles* from the text, and then *apply* these Scriptures to the circumstances of your life.
